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GEHL AND DERSE HEADQUARTERS NAMED TOP PROJECTS OF 2009

MILWAUKEE – *The Daily Reporter* and *Wisconsin Builder* have recognized the GEHL Company Headquarters and the Derse National Headquarters as two of the “Top Projects of 2009.” The annual Top Projects awards recognize projects that faced significant challenges, used new materials and techniques, or made important contributions to the communities they serve.



The State of Wisconsin, Washington County and the City of West Bend came together with the help of the Milwaukee 7 economic development platform to keep the Gehl Company in West Bend, the city where it was formed more than a century ago. Having received a \$7 million package of incentives from the City, County and State, Gehl agreed to build a new 77,880-square-foot office building for its headquarters as well as a separate 30,000-square-foot research and development center. EUA’s design for Gehl’s new facilities is defined by clean and modern lines, which provide a visual testament to the company’s sophisticated products.

EUA also designed a new 155,000-square-foot facility for Milwaukee-based Derse, Inc., a manufacturer of custom trade-show exhibits. The building, located in Milwaukee’s revitalized Menomonee Valley, accommodates both the company’s creative design component with 25,000 square feet of class-A office space, along with 130,000 square feet of industrial space sufficient for warehousing and light manufacturing operations. The facility also includes several sustainable design elements and is the first industrial building in Milwaukee to receive LEED® Silver Certification.
